'Who is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?'

Somewhere, in a locked storage unit, or an attic, or a barn, there's a painting: 'Storm on the Sea of Galilee,' which was stolen a generation ago, and hasn't been seen since. It's dark. The waves are huge. The boat is small, and at an angle. It is the only sea-scape Rembrandt ever painted. On the website of the museum where I used to go to stand and look at it, it was described like this: 'The biblical scene pitches nature against human frailty – both physical and spiritual. The panic-stricken disciples struggle against a sudden storm, and fight to regain control of their fishing boat as a huge wave crashes over its bow, ripping the sail and drawing the craft perilously close to the rocks in the left foreground. One of the disciples succumbs to the sea's violence by vomiting over the side. Amidst this chaos, only Christ, at the right, remains calm. Awakened by the disciples' desperate pleas for help, he rebukes them: "Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith?" and then rises to calm the fury of wind and waves.' I always marvelled at the peace of the figure of Jesus, illuminated by the gentle light of his own glory. We can't go back and take another look to see if that painting is as I remember it. There's an empty square on the wall where it hung. We can look at prints and copies, and, when the sky is dark and things seem overwhelming, retell the story, and renew our faith.
