Almighty God, who called your Church to bear witness that you were in Christ reconciling the world to yourself: help us to proclaim the good news of your love, that all who hear it may be drawn to you; through him who was lifted up on the cross, and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

Our first reading this Sunday is the story of God's anger at the Children of Israel, who, while Moses was on Mount Sinai receiving the tablets of the law, became impatient and demanded that Aaron make them something—anything—to worship. It is the story of the golden calf: pure, unvarnished, 24-karat unfaithfulness to God. Why are we reading it today then? It doesn't seem to



have much to do with our gospel, the parables of the lost sheep and the lost coin. The key, I think, is that both passages say that if we want to understand who God is and the nature of his power and his love, we have to take in the extraordinary lengths that he will go to find the lost. The Almighty Creator, the King of the Universe, is able to turn on a sixpence, to become humble—as we read in our second lesson, from 1 Timothy (verse 15): 'The saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners.' And everything Jesus is and does shows us what God is like.
