Lord of all power and might, the author and giver of all good things: graft in our hearts the love of your name, increase in us true religion, nourish us with all goodness, and of your great mercy, keep us in the same through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

Our Gospel today begins, 'The apostles gathered around Jesus, and told him all that they had done and taught. He said to them, "Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest a while.' For many were coming and going and they had no rest, even to eat.' Rest. A break from all the bustle and activity. Rest. A chance to renew, to stop, to slow. Rest. An end of work, if only for a



little while. Rest. An opportunity to stop doing, so that you may simply be. Rest. We all need to rest, not just to renew our strength to work and serve; to recuperate, but also to meet God. Note, though, that Mark wants us to see that it was difficult to the point of impossibility for Jesus and his disciples to find rest: the peaceful, deserted spot they were sailing towards was filled with an importunate crowd who had seen them coming. And Jesus had compassion on them. Truly, this man was the Son of God!
