Almighty God, who through your only-begotten Son Jesus Christ have overcome death and opened to us the gate of everlasting life: grant that by your grace going before us you put into our minds good desires, so by your continual help we may bring them to good effect; through Jesus Christ our risen Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

'I am the vine, you are the branches,' Jesus says. The fundamental point made here is that the relationship of Christ and Christians is a

moral one. If it does not express itself in love and service, it does not exist at all. We are related, Christ and Christians, Lord and disciples, not through blood but by love. The sap of the vine is love. It is for Philip to explain to the Ethiopian that being a eunuch doesn't make him a fruitless branch; he too can be grafted into Christ and flourish. Useless branches will be burned. It's an awful



thought, but Jesus's words are filled with the persuasion that the love of the Father will not let us go. 'Abide in me, as I abide in you,' Jesus says. 'Abiding' is a favourite word in John's Gospel. It refers to ideas like 'dwelling,' 'being,' 'bearing witness.' Love is a task as well as a gift.
